JeeEun Lee will present an illustrated autobiographical timeline that illustrates her personal journey from Korea to the United States. Becoming an artist in Korea is highly competitive and, in contrast to the United States, tends to be more conservative in both cultural and educational aspects. She has worked to bridge this divide, and the changes she went through are reflected in her artwork then and now. From Ms. Lee: "In my current practice, the elements of nature that inspire my work are water and mountains. For me, water is an essential element of nature and an object for meditation. Mountains convey limitless energy and make me think about space, time and my life."
