Vinyl Gloves for fold and dye

Yasutomo Sketch Paper is fine for both Suminagashi and Fold and Dye.

Students will be repeatedly skimming the surface of the water in the marbling tray with newspaper strips 2" x 14" - 4" longer than the short dimension of the tray.

Marbling tray – light colored plastic kitty litter trays 15.16"L x 10.43"W x 3.54"H Amazon has white ones

You will need several sheets of plexiglas or cookie sheets to rinse any papers that have an excess of color. Any soap residue in the marbling trays will make colors sink.
